Introduction



Welcome to the digital assessment Moodle platform of the Erasmus+ project <u>Q-Ed-Equalizing the chances of success</u> of pre-university students through a quality digital education.

The QEd Moodle platform includes 240 digital assessments tools for mother tongue, science, maths and English for basic education pupils in Romanian, Romanian sign language, Czech, Finnish. The platform also includes several thematic units with digital tests for the transdisciplinary reception of literary and non-literary texts. Here are a couple of aspects that make these tools truly outstanding:

- The texts for mother-tongue assessment tools have been picked up based on pupils' interests. The authors of the texts are internationally renowned and familiar to pupils.
- The topics of the assessment tools cover current and relevant themes, making learning easy to relate to life outside school. For example, the maths and science topics combine geometry, coding, map interpretation, first aid, and safety procedures knowledge.
- The maths and science assessments tools have been developed based on the curriculum requirements by experienced teachers in the project partner countries. They have created authentic texts, paying a special attention to the language used and the relevance of the content.
- The digital content in the Romanian language includes QR-codes that give access to videos in sign language, making the content accessible to students in the special education.

Each question is based on a piece of text or an illustration, that is displayed above the question. If you want to review a question later, you can click on the **Flag icon**.

The tests include a broad range of questions types, from multiple choice, true/false, short answer, numerical, matching, and more. To move between questions, click on the **Next page** button.

The source texts and the questions in the Romanian language are accompanied by **QR codes** that give access to videos with the same content in the sign language.

Quiz navigation

You can see where you are in the quiz by checking the **Quiz Navigation** window. A bold dark line highlights the number you are on. You can move to another question by clicking on its number.

When you are ready to submit your quiz, click on the **Submit all and finish** button on the last page.

What else do we need to know?

The e-learning platform http://www.q-ed.eu has several levels of access.

The administrator, has access to all courses and determines how the site looks. The administrator can also post messages of general interest on the module on the login page. All users of the platform receive these messages in their e-mail. The administrator creates courses / tests and user logins.

The teacher has full control over the tests, their administration and teaching, but cannot create student accounts.
